

Note on Outfall Locations and Numbering:

Discharge locations in peatland areas were previously identified on Drawing No. 001 – Plan of Relative Peat Failure Potential Along Pipeline Route in Peatland (AGEC Ltd, dated 14/06/2009). This plan did not show discharge locations at Glengad.

As part of the ongoing hydrological assessment of the land based sections of the proposed onshore pipeline route the outfall locations have been re-assessed and re-numbered. The re-numbering is necessary as the section of pipeline proposed in RosSPORT for the 2009 route no longer applies to the current route proposal.

The revised numbering of proposed outfalls is presented in the following Table:

Note 1: Only outfall locations common to both proposed routes are listed.

Note 2: This is a new outfall location from the proposed stringing area.

Note 3: This outfall is shown for clarity and discharge from this outfall will be dealt with within the existing terminal site drainage infrastructure.
