APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF DREDGE MATERIAL AT SEA FROM MAINTENANCE DREDGING WORKS TO PROVIDE SAFE NAVIGATIONAL DEPTHS AT HAULBOWLINE NAVAL BASE DURING EARLY 2010

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE has submitted an application to the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food for a permit under section 5 of the Dumping at Sea Act 1996 (as amended). The application is for the disposal of a maximum of 36,000 tonnes of dredge material (consisting of sand, silt and mud) from maintenance dredging at Haulbowline Naval Base. The proposed marine disposal site is located approximately 5.5km offshore south of Power Head.

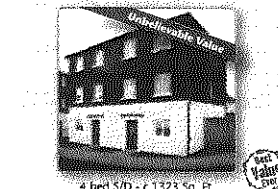
