ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 13A OF THE PETROLEUM AND OTHER MINERALS DEVELOPMENT ACT 1960 (AS AMENDED)

Notice is hereby given that Shell E&P Ireland Limited ("SEPII") (on behalf of SEPII, Statoil Exploration (Ireland) Limited and Vermilion Energy Ireland Limited) has made an application to the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources for approval of the working of petroleum consisting of revisions to the approved Plan of Development for the Corrib Gas Field Development Project.

The revisions relate to the proposed construction of a landfall valve installation at Glengad, County Mayo and a proposed modification of the onshore element of the Corrib pipeline route. This proposed modification of the onshore element of the pipeline route will extend from the landfall of the offshore pipeline to Bellanaboy Bridge Gas Terminal. The onshore pipeline route traverses the headland at Glengad, from there the route traverses Srúwaddacon Bay in a south-easterly direction to Aghoos, and then in an easterly direction across an area of peatland and forestry, before turning in a southerly direction and joining the previously approved route at Bellagelly before entering the Bellanaboy Bridge terminal site. The revision also includes the use of spare cores in the services umbilical to discharge treated produced water at the subsea manifold located at the Corrib gas field.

In compliance with section 13A of the Petroleum and Other Minerals Development Act 1960, as amended, SEPII has prepared and submitted on the 31st day of May 2010 an Environmental Impact Statement to the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources in support of its application for approval of the working of petroleum consisting of revisions to the approved Plan of Development for the Corrib Gas Field Development Project.
