IARRATAS AR AN AIRE CUMARSAIDE, FUINNIMH AGUS ACHMHAINNÍ NADÚRTHA Ó SHELL E&P IRELAND LIMITED FAOI ÁLT 40. DEN ACHT GÁIS MAR A LEASÁIDH LE TOILIÚ A FHÁIL LE PIBLINE DO GHÁS AICEANTA A THOGAIL Ó AISEANNA FO-THOINN GORT GÁS NA CORRIIBE GO DTÍ AN CRÍOCHPHORT AG DROICHEAD BHÉAL AN ÁTHA BHUI, BÉAL AN GHOILE THEAS, CO. MHAIGH EO

Dá réir sin tugtar fios leis an bhfógra go ndearna SHELL E&P Ireland Limited ("SEPL") (ar son SEPL, Statoil Exploration (Ireland) Limited agus Vermilion Energy Ireland Limited), iarratas faoi Ált 40 den Acht thuasluaite go dtí an tAire Cumarsaide. Fuinnimh agus Achmhainní Nádúrtha chun toiliú a fháil le píblíne do ghás aiceanta a thógail ó aiseanna fo-thoinn Gort Gás na Corriibe go dtí an críochphort gáis ag Droichead Bhéal an Atha Bhui, Béal an Ghoile Theas, Contae Mhaigh Eo.

Tá faid c. 91.7km agus trastomhas c. 508mm ag an piobán gáis atá beartaithe agus leanfaidh sé bealach farráige ó Gort Gás na Corriibe go sroicheadh sé an cladach ag Glenn an Ghad (Dún Ceartáin) i gCuan an Inbhir, Co Mhaigh Eo. Sinfidh an tathchóiriú molta den chuid iníre sin de bhealach an phíblíne ón bpointe ar an gcladach a dtagann an piobán i dtír go dtí an Críochphort Gáis ag Droichead Bhéal an Atha Bhui. Tógfaidh an píblíne iníre bealach thar rinn Ghleann an Ghaid agus uaidh sin soir ó dheas trí Bhá Sruithmhadaogcon I dtreo na hEochú, agus ansin soir ag gearradh trí cheantair portaigh agus fairsaíse uilg gcasann sé ó dheas chun ceangal le bealach a bhí faofa cheana féin ag Béal an Ghoile Theas agus ansin ag críochnú ag suíomh an chríochphoirt Gáis ag Droichead Bhéal an Atha Bhui.

Timpeall 83.4km atá sa phiobán atá faoi mhuir agus 8.3km san fhaid thar thalamh agus síneadh ón gcladach go dtí an críochphort.

Séard atá i gcóras an phíblíne atá beartaithe ná an píblíne féin, imleacán ainmniúil bainteach le seirbhísí, a bhfuil trastomhas 130mm aige, agus síneadh idir Gort Gás na Corriibe agus an cladach agus 3 (Uimh) imleacán a bhfuil trastomhas níos lú fós acu, agus cáblaíocht ríachtanach eile ag síneadh ón gcladach go dtí an críochphort, chomh maith le piobán discaoilte a bhfuil trastomhas 250mm aige, go pointe atá c.12.7km ón gcladach taobh amuigh de Bhá Chuan an Inbhir. Os cionn talún, mar chuid den fhorbairt bheartaithe, tá Comhla Insealbhathe an Chladaigh, ina bhfuil comhlaí agus instraimintí, suite i mbaile fearann Ghleann an Ghad (Dún Ceartáin). Tá an t-insealbhú deartha sa chaoi is go gcuirfeir teoirinn leis an mbrú laistigh den phíblíne iníre go leibhéal 100 bar, nó níos ísle.

GAS ACT 1976 AS AMENDED

APPLICATION TO THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNICATIONS, ENERGY AND NATURAL RESOURCES BY SHELL E&P IRELAND LIMITED UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE GAS ACT AS AMENDED FOR CONSENT TO CONSTRUCT A NATURAL GAS PIPELINE FROM CORRIB GAS FIELD SUBSEA FACILITIES TO BELLANABOY BRIDGE GAS TERMINAL, BELLAGELLY SOUTH, COUNTY MAYO

Notice is hereby given that Shell E&P Ireland Limited ("SEPL") (on behalf of SEPL, Statoil Exploration (Ireland) Limited and Vermilion Energy Ireland Limited) has made an application under Section 40 of the above Act to the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources for consent to construct a natural gas pipeline from the Corrib Gas Field subsea facilities to the gas terminal at Bellanaboy Bridge, Bellagelly South, County Mayo.

The proposed gas pipeline is approximately 91.7km in length and 508mm in diameter and will follow an offshore route from the Corrib Gas Field to a landfill at Glengad (Dooncarton) in Broadhaven Bay, County Mayo. This proposed modification of the onshore element of the pipeline route will extend from the landfill of the offshore pipeline to Bellanaboy Bridge Gas Terminal. The onshore pipeline route traverses the headland at Glengad, from there the route traverses Sruwaddacon Bay in a south-easterly direction to Aghoos, and then in an easterly direction across an area of peatland and forestry, before turning in a southerly direction and joining the previously approved route at Bellagelly before entering the Bellanaboy Bridge terminal site.

The offshore section is approximately 83.4km in length, and the proposed onshore section is approximately 8.3km long, extending from the landfill to the terminal.

The proposed pipeline system is comprised of the gas pipeline itself, an associated 130 mm nominal diameter services umbilical, extending between the Corrib Gas Field and the landfill, and 3 no. smaller diameter umbilicals and other essential cabling extending from the landfill to the Terminal, as well as a 250 mm diameter outfall discharge pipeline from the Terminal to a point approximately 12.7km from the Landfall outside Broadhaven Bay. The proposed development also includes an above-ground Landfall Valve Installation, comprising of valves and instrumentation located in the townland of Glengad (Dooncarton). This installation is designed to limit pressure in the onshore pipeline to 100 bar or less.

Written submissions or observations with regard to the said proposed application may be made in writing to the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources, Petroleum Affairs Division, 29-31 Adelaide Road, Dublin 2, for a period of one month starting 30th June 2010 until 30th July 2010 both dates inclusive.
